Registering for the University Alliances Community (UAC)



Introduction:

The University Alliances Community (UAC) home base is within the SAP Community Network (SCN). Educators from around the world download academic materials, participate in forums and take advantage of the many resources the SCN community provides. The public portion of our community is available to educators as well as students and anyone else who is interested in learning more about SAP and ERP technology. **Step A below outlines how to register for the UAC public community.**

Professors using SAP software in the classroom as members of the traditional University Alliances Program may additionally access members-only content available on the private UAC workspace. Members-only content includes curriculum materials, faculty development opportunism, help forums and other program resources. Because this content has restricted access, you need to let our team know that you need access. **Step B below outlines how to get access to UAC members-only content.**

A. Register for the University Alliances Community (UAC)

1. Go to www.uac.sap.com

2. Choose “**not a member?**”

Or - click “register” at the top of any page

3. Do you have an **S#** (service marketplace ID) AND know your password? If yes, select the “**Existing Service Marketplace (S-user)**” radio button on the registration page. Then skip to Step 5.

Note: If you do not normally use your S#, we recommend you get a new P# (see next step).

4. OR - Choose the “**Public User Registration**” radio button. Enter required information.

Display Name: What others see when you post / contribute on UAC.

Email: Use campus email address.

Industry: Higher Education & Research

Profession: Professor / lecturer


Discipline: Many to choose from

Remember to check participation in UAC as well as “yes” to receiving the UA newsletter and communications.

5. Choose “**register**”. You will receive an email confirmation with your new user ID (P#) and temporary password.

6. Click on the link within the email to activate your account.

*NOTE: If you already utilize any of the communities within SCN – SAP Developers Network (SDN), Business Process Expert (BPX) or Business Objects Community (BOC), then you can already access UAC pages. Please edit your profile (choose “**My Profile**” then “**Update Profile**” from the top of any page) to indicate membership in the “UAC community” and “yes” to receive the UA newsletter to ensure you can view all UAC content and receive our communications.*

B. Request access to the UAC members-only, private content.

Professors using SAP software in the classroom as members of the traditional SAP University Alliances program are encouraged to request access to members-only content, help forums and other program resources. *Please note: Students may not have access to this private content!*

Post a request for UAC access in Getting Started [FACULTY - post here if you need access to UAC workspace](#). Remember to include your **name**, **user ID** and **university** in your post.

Tips & Tricks

The error message members see most frequently is below.

Look at the upper left corner of the message.

If it indicates “Welcome Guest”, most likely you have not yet logged on when executing a UAC link.

Choose “log-in” to enter your user ID and password.

If it displays your name after “Welcome”, it is possible you do not yet have access to the UAC private workspace and members-only content.

Post your name, campus name and user ID (P#/S#) for access:
